### 2012 All Star Teams / Part Time Travel

All BBAA baseball players age 7 through 14 and softball players age 9 through 14 are eligible to tryout for part time travel (All Star teams). The BBAA will partner with Wood Dale (WDBA) and form baseball and softball teams at the 10U, 12U, and 14U levels. The 8U baseball team will remain BBAA only. Tryouts will be held by the end of May and games will begin in late May or early June. Players will play 1 or 2 games a week in addition to their house team games and will play in 3 or 4 tournaments during the month of July. More details will be available at registration.
